• Clarify alignment with LNA's mission and vision: Discuss how expanding the Lyndale Education Program beyond Lyndale impacts our commitment to our neighborhood.

Funding works by comparing student contact hours 2024 +18% relative to 2023; state average 18% so our funding stays the same We need to increase student hours in order to compete with the state average and maintain funding.

- Assess neighborhood and regional needs: Consider whether neighboring areas have similar needs that justify program expansion.
- Discuss potential geographic boundaries: Gather input on priority areas for expansion (e.g., neighboring neighborhoods, South Minneapolis, all of Minneapolis, Hennepin County).
